

Can you create salt dough using: 2 cups of flour 1 cup of salt 1 cup of water

Instructions:

- 1. In a large bowl mix salt and flour together.
- 2. Gradually stir in water. Mix well until it forms a doughy consistency.
- 3. Turn the **dough** onto the bench and knead with your hands until smooth and combined.
- 4. Make your creations using the salt dough.
- 5. Place the **salt dough creations** into the oven at 180C.



Can you create a rainbow like the one above? Or you could create your own design!



You could make decorations for your home! These have been made by pressing different plants and leaves into the dough.
