






My child feels safe at school, please ask them.




The school meets my child's particular needs.









Teaching at this school is good or better than good.













The school keeps me well informed.






My child enjoys the lessons in school.




There is a good range of subjects available to my child at this school. 80 responses




My child can take part in clubs and activities at this school.


The school supports my child's wider personal development.



- Just keep doing more of what you do!
- Less focus on homework
- Encourage the pupils to celebrate their diversity.
- Differentiated homework for SEN, spelling tests that are accessible for all

- Too many messages becomes confusing
- If there was a possibility of allowing weekly flexible meals, especially with the introduction of halal meals. It would be great if for example we could choose which 2/3 days our child could have a hot meal. Unfortunately, a commitment for a whole half term/term isn't possible but a couple of times a week would be.

- Help children build confidence encouraging less confident children to have bigger
 parts in assemblies to build confidence sometimes it feels like the same children have
 the bigger parts every year. More opportunities to develop speaking skills.
- More condensed correspondence sometimes we get 3 or 4 ParentApp messages a day.
- As far as I am concerned, Beaumont is doing brilliantly in every aspect of schooling
- Offer my children clubs as they do get full very quickly
- Maybe a few more trips in the year
- Having an Eid Party for kids as many kids in school celebrate Eid.
- Encourage children to celebrate their diversity.
- Offer competitive sports and be better prepared competing with others e.g. practice ahead, sport kits, transport etc. When they play together, it feels like individuals coming together, rather than being a team. This maybe the same within the school which then translates into a Good school rather than outstanding.

Our response:

Our commitment to you is that we will take all these comments on board and work towards the improvements that have been suggested, if they are in the best interest of the school.

The outstanding status for Ofsted is also the aim for the governors and I. We are due a visit from Ofsted next academic year however, we are in an unfortunate situation with regards to the timings. This is because the process of moving from good to outstanding has to be proven over two inspections that are at least two years apart. This intends to prove the school is outstanding over a period of time rather than a one off visit like previous inspections.

We are aiming for outstanding and this survey is more evidence to prove we are an improving school in which parents are overwhelmingly happy with the education and experiences we provide for the Beaumont children.
