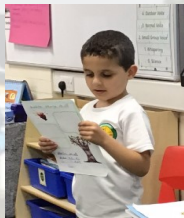


### Beaumont Primary School Vision

## Democracy in action at Beaumont!

In Learning for Life this half term, Rec, Y1, Y2 and Y3 children have been learning about British Values.
