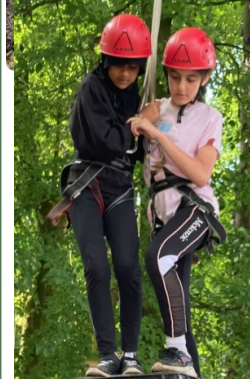


Year Six Residential!
