School Dinners

- **Changing type of dinner** – Please make sure that you inform the office if your child is changing from packed lunches to school dinners, or from school dinners to packed lunches.
- **Free School Meals** - If you have recently received confirmation from Bolton Council that your child is entitled to free school meals, please bring in your letter so that we can update our systems and apply for the appropriate funding and support.
- **Paying for school dinners** - if you pay for your child's school dinners, please make sure you pay in advance, either weekly, monthly or half termly. We will start to follow up unpaid school dinners in the next few weeks, so please pay any outstanding balance.
- **Interested in changing to School Dinners?** We now have a full Halal menu which means that we only use HMC Certified Halal meat and the School Food Standards set by the Government. Check out the further information and our menu overleaf. But please let the office know if your child is changing from packed lunches to school dinners.

Contact Information

The office team is currently working on ensuring that all yours and your child's information is correct on all of our systems and apps. Please bear with us as we complete this work, but for now please can you:

- **Change of contact details** - please make sure you inform us of any changes to your contact details - address, contact number and email address.
- **Change of contacts** - as a school we have to have at least two contacts for each child. Please think carefully about who does, or may collect your child from school either at the end of the day or in an emergency, and make sure that the office has this information to update on your child's record.

- **Bookings** - bookings for Bright Stars can be made online a week in advance or by emailing the brightstars@beaumont.bolton.sch.uk. Please give us as much notice as possible but we are very flexible and can usually accommodate last minute requests.
- **Payments** - please should be made via the Payments section in the ParentApp or via the government's childcare voucher scheme. Please pay promptly. We will start to follow up unpaid school dinners in the next few weeks, so please pay any outstanding balance.
