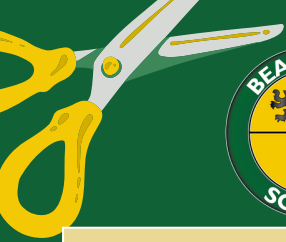
Have a look in your child's book bag and take a look to see if you can give your child the best possible start to their spring term.
